About 385 Hts

The Galeon 385 Hts meets market demand with its all-weather hardtop, but also its spectacular hull-length side view windows. In continuing the highly acclaimed 325 design-line created by Tony Castro, the automatic sliding roof gives the sensation of an open sport cruiser while still providing protection from the elements.

The eye-catching, dual-colored 385 hull has dynamic features like low-cut side windows, which brighten the lower deck interior and provide a futuristic look. A series of skylights dividing the bow sundeck bathe the master bedroom in natural light. Meanwhile, the main deck follows current top trends of a flush floor.

A new hydraulic garage/BAR system comes standard and can accommodate a tender or personal watercraft up to 2.2 m in length.

A retractable roof atop the roomy helm station, provides protection from the elements when necessary. If that were not enough, a marquee that opens and retracts automatically from the roofing protects the cockpit from sun and rain.

The Galeon 385 Hts offers diverse living space - from the C-shaped settee, chaise lounge, wet bar exterior gallery, to the helm station. The accommodation lower deck features an L-shaped gallery, L-shaped saloon, owner's suite to fore with private bathroom and double cabin aft also with private bathroom - luxuries rarely seen in this class.

As with every Galeon, great performance and precise handling is a guarantee in the 385 Hts. Add to that power options ranging from 2x 200 hp to 2x 370 hp and you have great boat for just about any occasion.
